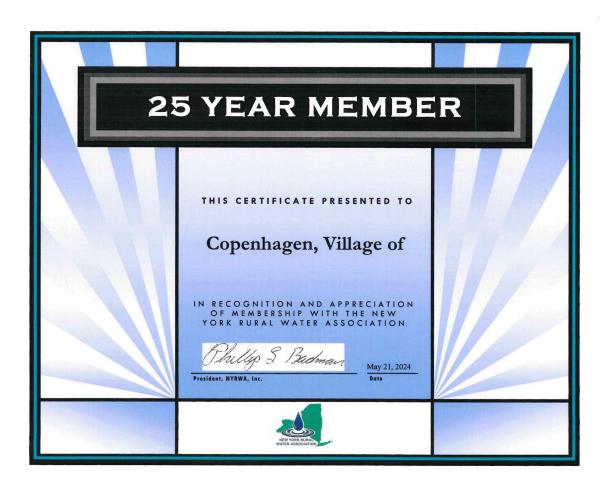

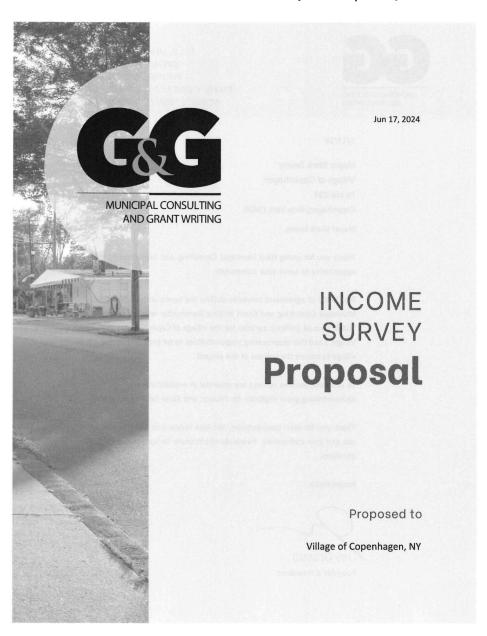

This need is not always obvious, especially in communities that are on the cusp of eligibility according to the American Community Survey (ACS).
