

Specifically, I would need answers to the questions **highlighted in yellow**, as well as ranking the projects by priority, and the rest I could complete on your behalf. Please note that the grant may require up to a 25% project funds match, which of course could potentially be covered with supplemental grant funds. **The final application is due March 31st**.

Then, if you were to make it to next stages of grant consideration you would be contacted directly by the Congressional Office to gather supplemental information and application materials, and proceed with the project from there.

Let me know if this is of interest or if you have any follow up questions, and I look forward to hearing from you.
