PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE LAW UPDATE

SECTION 17: DECLARATION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE AND REMEDIATION

At the close of the public hearing, the Village Board of Trustees may determine that the conditions upon the subject property which violate this law constitute a public nuisance. Upon a determination by the Village Board of Trustees that conditions upon the property constitute a public nuisance, the Board is empowered to authorized officers, agents or employees of the Village to enter onto the property to remove any vehicle, boat, boat trailer, uninhabitable mobile home, inoperable machinery, solid waste, rubbish or debris stored, deposited, placed or maintained in violation of this Chapter and disposed of or otherwise destroy the same, Any cost and expenses incurred by the Village when acting pursuant to this Chapter to abate a public nuisance shall be assessed against the property involved and shall constitute a lien thereon to be collected as provided by law, and may be added to the next Village real property tax assessment against said property and collected in the manner truces are collected.
