Repeal and Replace
Section 18 of Local Law No. 4 of 2010
Property Maintenance**

The intent of the proposed action is to repeal "Section 18: Emergency Actions" which exists in the Village of Copenhagen Property Maintenance Law (Local Law No. 4 of 2010) and replace the same with a new "Section 18: Emergency Actions" within the Property Maintenance Law of the Village of Copenhagen.

Once the existing Section 18 is repealed, it shall be replaced with the following:

Section 18: Emergency Actions

Where it reasonably appears that there is a present danger to the life, safety, or health of any person or property and such danger is attributable to unsanitary conditions related to garbage, litter, refuse, rubbish, and/or debris, and that such danger will exist until the offending garbage, litter, refuse, rubbish, and/or debris is removed, the Village Board may by resolution authorize the immediate removal of the same. Written notice of the same shall be provided to persons having interests in the property within a reasonable time and such notice shall be posted at the property.

The actual cost of correcting such condition [minimum charge of one (1) hour labor and one (1) hour equipment, plus materials], plus five percent (5%) thereof for inspection and other costs in connection therewith, shall be calculated and certified by the Village Clerk and shall thereafter become and be a lien upon the property whereon such condition exists and/or is located and shall be added to and become a part of the taxes next to be assessed and levied upon such lot or land and shall bear interest at the same rate as taxes and shall be collected and enforced by the same officer and in the same manner as taxes.

**ENACT LOCAL LAW NO. ___ of 2025
REPEAL AND REPLACE SECTION 18 OF LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 2010
PROPERTY MAINTENANCE**

WHEREAS, the Village Board for the Village of Copenhagen, New York is interested in enacting a Local Law repealing and replacing Section 18 of the Village Property Maintenance Law; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined to proceed with legislation regarding Property Maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has reviewed the proposed legislation and has further determined that enacting the same would be in the best interests of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Board of the Village of Copenhagen, New York as follows:

1. The forgoing recitation is incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if set forth hereafter.
2. The Village Board hereby enacts the Local Law repealing and replacing Section 18 of the Village Property Maintenance Law as being in the best interests of the Village of Copenhagen.
3. The Mayor for the Village of Copenhagen and the Village Clerk for the Village of Copenhagen, their respective agents and employees are authorized to sign all documents and take all steps necessary to enact this legislation.

I have had people go and weed eat it earlier in the season as well in past year. I have even offered to meet the village lawn mower to show him . it has a stone border on the garden so pretty easy I think. This village crew mows and maintains as well as weed eat several places in the village even property that the village does not own but a beautiful park we now have is given second rate care. They weed eat the bandstand area but for some reason can't do the park. I believe they have no excuse other than lack of want. I have volunteered to help by showing them where it needs trimming and no one has ever reached out to any of my family asking for some guidance it is just ignored and allowed to grow up in to a mess. Then I end up paying someone to go up and do it because I can't stand seeing it being neglected.

I also asked one of the village guys about why the picnic tables have never had stain or preservative on them to protect so they last a long time. I even offered the same stain the pavilion has to them. Once again someone worked hard and donated these to have no maintenance and actually left under eaves last winter and the snow coming off roof buried them. My answer was "no one has ever told us to do it". Seriously anyone knows that to preserve outdoor items they need a little maintenance.

I know the village board members have made the effort to get the park trimmed up but apparently it has fallen on deaf ears.

I am hoping by writing this letter that it will give your village employees a little fire to get motivated to make this park as beautiful as it should be so many people will be able to enjoy it for many many years.
