ALTERING SCHOOL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES BY CONSENT**

In the Matter of the Boundary Alteration Between the Copenhagen Central School District and the South Jefferson Central School District

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Copenhagen Central School District, at a duly noticed regular meeting held on July 22, 2025, adopted a resolution approving a boundary alteration petition involving three parcels located in the South Jefferson Central School District, contingent upon approval of the South Jefferson Central School District; and

WHEREAS, the District Clerk of the Copenhagen Central School District certified that said resolution was adopted by a vote of 5 yes, 0 no, with no abstentions indicated, and certified the resolution on July 23, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the South Jefferson Central School District, at a duly noticed regular meeting held on August 20, 2025, adopted a resolution approving and consenting to the transfer of Parcel ID Nos. **2.00-1-5.1, 2.00-1-5.2, and 2.00-1-5.3**, owned respectively by **Clinton Goutremout, Anthony Young, and Mathew Cooper**, from the South Jefferson Central School District to the Copenhagen Central School District; and

WHEREAS, the South Jefferson Central School District Board of Education determined that the transfer was in the District's interest for reasons related to transportation concerns, the best educational interests of impacted children, and the de minimis impact on the South Jefferson Central School District; and

WHEREAS, the South Jefferson Central School District's resolution expressly provides that the parcel transfer and boundary alteration is subject to approval by the District Superintendent for the Jefferson-Lewis Board of Cooperative Educational Services, including issuance of an order to effect the transfer and appropriate filing of the order; and

WHEREAS, the South Jefferson Central School District Clerk certified that the resolution was approved by vote of 7 yes, 0 no, at the Board's regular meeting held August 20, 2025, and certified the resolution on August 26, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the affected school districts have consented to the proposed alteration of boundaries; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to New York Education Law § 1507, with the written consent of the trustees or boards of education of all districts to be affected, the District Superintendent may make an order altering the boundaries of any school district within the District Superintendent's jurisdiction and fix in such order the day on which the alteration shall take effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Christopher DiFulvio District Superintendent of Schools for the Jefferson-Lewis-Hamilton-Herkimer-Oneida Board of Cooperative Educational Services, having reviewed the resolutions and certifications submitted by the Copenhagen Central School District and the South Jefferson Central School District, and being satisfied that the required consents have been duly granted,

DO HEREBY ORDER that the boundaries of the Copenhagen Central School District and the South Jefferson Central School District are altered so that Parcel ID Nos. **2.00-1-5.1, 2.00-1-5.2, and 2.00-1-5.3** are transferred from the South Jefferson Central School District to the Copenhagen Central School District.

The boards of education of the Copenhagen Central School District and the South Jefferson Central School District have agreed to an alteration of their school district boundary lines. In accordance with New York Education Law 1507, as the District Superintendent of the Sole Supervisory District of Jefferson, Lewis, Hamilton, Herkimer and Oneida Counties (Jefferson-Lewis-Hamilton-Herkimer-Oneida BOCES), I have issued an order altering the boundary lines between those districts.

I am hereby filing with you my order together with a consent resolution from both boards of education of the Copenhagen Central School District and the South Jefferson Central School District. I have contemporaneously filed this order with the respective town clerks, respective board clerks, and respective county tax assessors.

The Copenhagen Central School District and the South Jefferson Central School District submitted to me the aforementioned resolutions regarding the proposed school district boundary alteration affecting the following parcels currently situated within the South Jefferson Central School District:

Subsequently, the Board of Education of the South Jefferson Central School District, at its duly noticed regular meeting held on August 20, 2025, adopted a formal resolution approving and consenting to the transfer of the above-referenced parcels from the South Jefferson Central School District to the Copenhagen Central School District, together with the necessary alteration of district boundary lines to effectuate such transfer.

The South Jefferson Central School District resolution further determined that the requested alteration is supported by transportation considerations, the best educational interests of the children impacted, and the de minimis effect on the South Jefferson Central School District.

Accordingly, both affected school districts have formally approved the proposed boundary alteration through official action of their respective Boards of Education. Certified copies of the adopted resolutions are enclosed herewith for review and inclusion in the administrative record. My order is consistent with the above and shall take effect on July 1, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT


